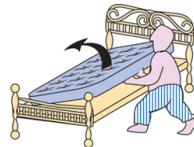

- Miscellaneous - appliances, mattresses, furniture, junk, etc. (No refrigerators or air conditioners)
- Non-Recyclable Materials – ivy, succulents, pressure treated wood
~PLEASE KEEP THESE MATERIALS SEPARATE FROM RECYCLABLE RESIDENTIAL GREEN WASTE~
- Electronic Waste – computer equipment, TVs, cell phones, fax machines
- Universal Waste – fluorescent light tubes, light bulbs, household batteries

FREE Hazardous Waste & Electronic Waste Disposal for Newbury Park & Casa Conejo Residents:

Newbury Park & Casa Conejo residents can dispose of household hazardous waste (HHW) and electronic waste (E-waste) at two nearby locations. The **City of Thousand Oaks Household Hazardous Waste Facility** offers HHW and E-waste drop-off on Fridays & Saturdays throughout the year (closed holidays). Appointments are required. Visit www.toaks.org/gogreen or call (805) 449-7283 to schedule an appointment. **Clean Harbors**, located in Camarillo, accepts HHW and E-waste and is open on the 2nd Friday and Saturday of the month. Call (805) 987-0717 to schedule an appointment. Accepted materials include: paint, pesticides, propane tanks, solvents, household cleaners, pool chemicals, automotive products, fluorescent light tubes, motor oil, used oil filters, household & auto batteries, and E-waste.

Per State law, residents are limited to a maximum of 15 gallons, or 125 pounds, of HHW per trip.
