## SUPERVISOR LINDA PARKS SEEKS TO FILL OPEN SEATS ON VENTURA COUNTY COUNCILS AND COMMITTEES

**THOUSAND OAKS, CA (November 29, 2016) -** Ventura County Supervisor Linda Parks is looking to fill open seats on county appointed councils and committees in District 2. Serving on a local council or committee is an excellent way to give back to the community and ensure your ideas are heard.

- Municipal Advisory Councils (MACs) in Oak Park, Casa Conejo and Somis
   MACs provide a community forum for residents of unincorporated areas to discuss issues
   of land use, neighborhood beautification, roadways and other infrastructure, and make
   recommendations to the Board of Supervisors. Two seats are available on both the Oak
   Park MAC and Casa Conejo MAC, and one alternate seat on the Somis MAC.
- <u>Ventura County Waterworks District #19 Citizens' Advisory Committee</u>
  Waterworks District #19 serves the Somis community and surrounding rural areas. The
  Advisory Council operates as a liaison between the community and the Waterworks
  District by providing input regarding annual budgets, water and sanitation rate
  adjustments, capital improvement projects, annexation issues, and new policy items.
- <u>Women's Economic Roundtable (WER)</u>
  The WER is a ten-member advisory board that promotes economic development and career opportunities for women in Ventura County. The WER also provides career assistance, mentorship opportunities, and organizes a women's conference that addresses financial literacy and pay equity gaps for women in the workforce. Applicants who are members of existing women's organizations are encouraged to apply.
