Supervisor Linda Parks Announces: "Money Talk with California Treasurer Bill Lockyer" Quarterly Dinner Series on Policy and Government

THOUSAND OAKS, CA - **Ventura County Supervisor Linda Parks** will be hosting another dinner in her Quarterly Dinner Series on Thursday, December 12th. The dinner's featured speaker is California State Treasurer Bill Lockyer who will speak candidly about Public Pensions, School Bonds, High Speed Rail Bonds, Student Debt, and his thoughts about financing and investing our tax dollars. There is a question and answer period afterwards.

The quarterly dinner meetings provide a forum for discussion on government policy and are open to the public by reservation. The **December 12th** dinner is \$40 per person in advance and will be at Tuscany il Ristorante in Westlake Village. It is anticipated to sell out so reservations should be made as soon as possible. California State Treasurer Bill Lockyer oversees trillions of dollars in State transactions every year. He sells California's bonds, invests its money and manages its cash. And he handles those duties while sitting on the governing boards of the nation's two largest public pension funds - the California Public Employees' Retirement System and the California State Teachers' Retirement System. Mr. Lockyer has served in the State Senate and as the State's Attorney General and has never lost an election in his 46 years of public service.

Supervisor Parks represents Ventura County's 2nd District, which includes the communities of Thousand Oaks, Newbury Park, Westlake Village, Lynn Ranch, Oak Park, Santa Rosa Valley, Somis, Bell Canyon, Hidden Valley, Lake Sherwood, Malibu-Yerba Buena, as well as portions of the Oxnard Plain.
