Supervisor Zaragoza Commends Chief John Crombach at the Ventura County Board of Supervisors

Ventura - November 2, 2010 - The Ventura County Board of Supervisors, commended Oxnard Police Chief, John Crombach, for his 32 years of service.

Fifth District Supervisor Zaragoza, who presented the resolution to the Chief stated, "I am honored to be presenting this resolution from the Board of Supervisors. I personally want thank you for all of the work you have done in Oxnard and without a doubt, your influence has extended throughout the county." Supervisor Zaragoza further stated, "When I was a councilman for the City of Oxnard, together we worked on many issues and community based organizations. The Chief's desire to create a better understanding between the communities and the Police Department has resulted in a positive outcome, making Oxnard one of the five safest cities, of its size in the nation."

Award in 2008 for Excellence in Community Policing. In recent years, Oxnard has enjoyed a sharp decline in crime rate dropping nearly 65% since 1992.
