#### First 5 NfL's

- Interface staff provide support and technical assistance to trained and accredited NfL staff who implement seminars, tip sheet presentations and brief consultations also known as Level 2 and Level 3.
- Interface staff work together with the NfL staff to identify appropriate referrals for Triple P and to engage the families in culturally informed services provided in the families primary language.
- NfL staff have requested individual services, seminars and tipsheet talks.

➤ What Do Outcomes Tell Us?



- Prevents further entry of families into other systems.
- Decreases symptoms and improves child behavior.
- · Increases both the child's and family's functioning.
- · Improves family connections and communications.
- · Increases child's school performance.
- · Increases parents' confidence with parenting skills.
- Builds a stronger attachment between parent and child.



What Community Partners and Parents Have to Say About Triple P



- "Triple P gives parents tools. Families give us feedback about how much it helps their family's functioning, their connection with each other and their ability to talk with one another."

#### **Program Recommendations**

Ventura County HSA data reports a substantial increase in child abuse reports in Camarillo for 2012. Triple P America outcomes indicate a decrease in child abuse reports where Triple P is provided. Therefore, Interface proposes a 20% budget increase to implement School Based Triple P to the Camarillo School District.
