These funds will support projects to serve individuals who face the greatest barriers to employment through a joint collaboration with Local Workforce Development Boards (Local Board) and community-based organizations (CBO).

Applications must include a partnership between a Local Board and a mission-driven CBO with a history of providing services to the target population(s) specified.

The WDBVC is moving forward with preparing an application to support career and workforce development services in the Ventura County Region. The WDBVC also supported an LOI submitted to the CWDB by Westminster Free Clinic.
