## What's happening at your airports.....

First off, thanks for your continuing patience with the multiple construction projects underway. We realize it is an inconvenience and we appreciate your understanding. The improvements will be worth it!

### CMA Tower and Airport Staff request your help.

- CMA has had a disproportionate number of runway incursion incidents - pilots taxiing across the hold short line at Taxiway "A" without tower clearance to take the runway. Please LISTEN carefully for your specific aircraft ID and clearance to take off (or position and hold). **IF IN DOUBT, DO NOT CROSS THE HOLD SHORT.** Experienced pilots are making this mistake, and although additional signage/markings will be installed, incursions can only be prevented by the pilot.

- When clearing the active runway, taxi well south of the Hold Short Line on the exiting taxiway before slowing down or stopping to clean-up your aircraft or change frequency - Tower cannot land traffic until an exiting aircraft is completely clear (south) of the runway (hold short line).

- Local Procedure at Run-Up area. After completing run-up at the Taxiway "G" Run-Up area, aircraft are required to contact Ground Control 121.8 with a "Run-Up Complete" call before taxiing.

- DOA Maintenance has painted a vehicle driving lane on the airfield. Two white lines from the tower to the wash rack area define the driving lane for east-west movement on airfield. Except when giving way to aircraft, all vehicles are required to use it for vehicle movements. **REMEMBER,** maximum vehicle speed on the airport is 15 MPH.

- CMA and OXR - The waste oil sites are for waste oil only. Do not leave batteries, oil containers, or other trash. Oil filters are OK when they are left in the oil filter receptacle. Also, **NO BATTERIES IN OR AROUND DUMPSTERS.** Please dispose of properly.
