Department of Airports' Rent and Fee Schedule

The Rent and Fee Schedule was adopted by the Board of Supervisors On Tuesday, June 7th. The department conducted a cost recovery analysis, per the Board's policy, looking at the "big picture" of revenues vs. expenses. Based on the results of the analysis, hangar and tiedown rents will not be adjusted in FY 2005-06. Some rates will be adjusted up including aviation land and ramp rates for FBO's, pay parking at the Oxnard Airport Terminal (+\$1), and various fees for commercial activities.

What's Happening at Camarillo Airport

- East End Hangar Development - The first two hangar buildings are up at the east end and the developer is preparing to pour the foundation for the next two, which includes one row of T-hangars. Occupancy of the first set of hangars is anticipated very soon.
- The enhanced security system (access control) is up and running and a letter explaining the process to obtain new gates cards will be issued by the end of July.

What's Happening at Oxnard Airport

- A new flight school is operating at Hangar 3 as a subtenant of Aspen Helicopters / Oxnard Jet Center. Aviation Pacific can be reached at 382-4584.
- New security fencing has been installed along the east, south, and west perimeters of the airport.
- Additional projects coming soon include ramp rehabilitation and perimeter fence upgrade along the north side of the airport.

RUNWAY SAFETY – BACK TO THE BASICS

Know your airport signs and pavement markings. Every sign and marking tells you something about where you are, where you are going, and where you can (can not) go.

REMINDERS

- Avoid overflight of noise sensitive areas whenever possible.
- Obey the traffic rules and regulations in effect at the airports.
- Wait for vehicle gates to close behind you (be sure to clear the "gate loop" so the gate closes without delay – NO TAILGATING!
- Help keep the airports safe by keeping them clean.
- No dumping of anything other than used motor oil and oil filters at the Waste Oil Recycling sheds (personal aircraft use only, no businesses).
- Dumpsters are for airport waste only, not household goods, old beds and/or office furniture!
- Be aware of TFR's by checking NOTAMs.
- Animals must be on a leash and under owners control, AND please clean up after them!!
