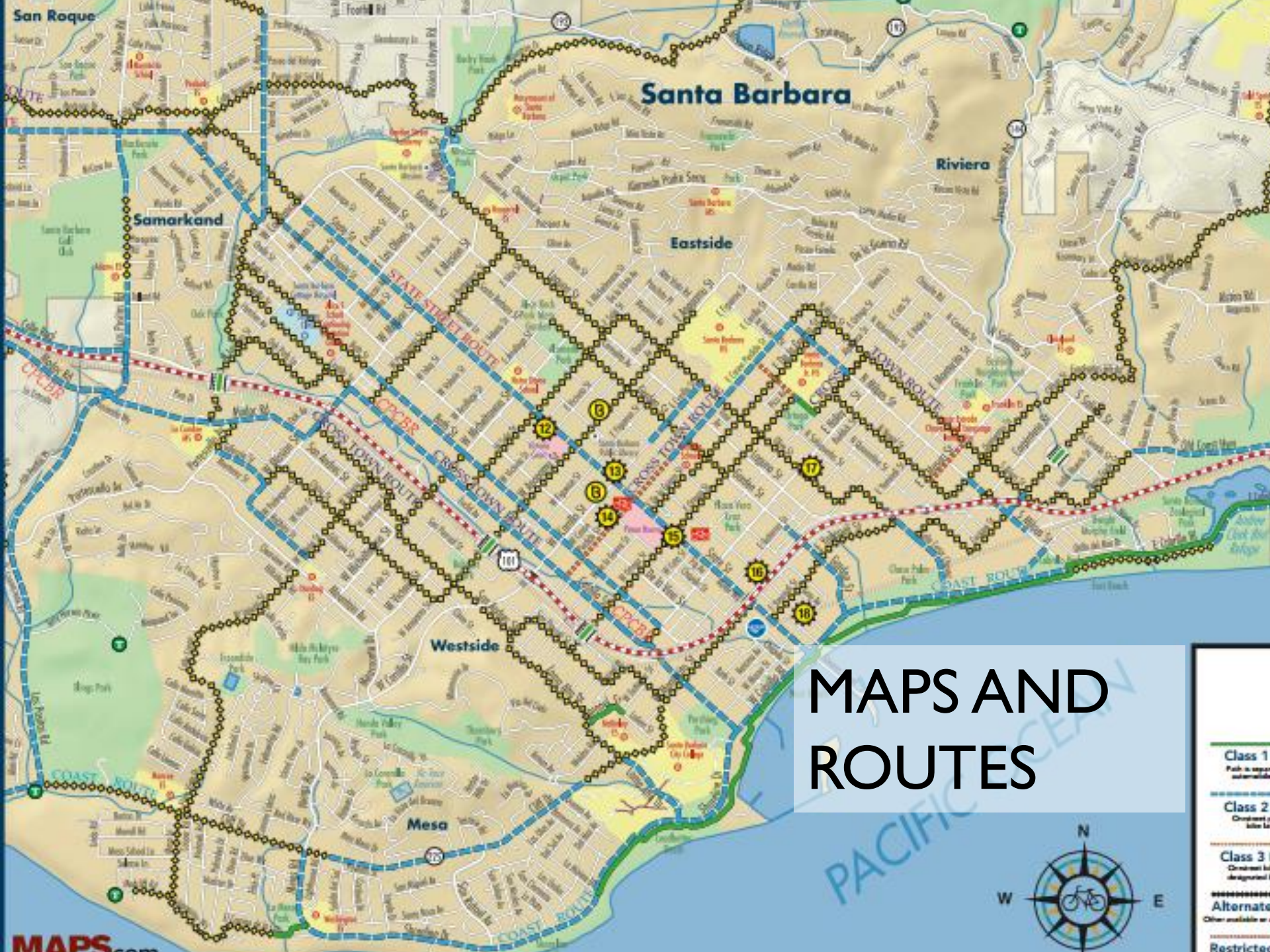


Map for bike shop santa barbara

I am a bit reluctant to write a review about this cycling path, which is well-known among locals but pretty much unknown outside its immediacy. Even on weekends there are not many cyclists around, which makes for a peaceful ride. I ride from Ventura to Ojai, stop at Foster park, use the restrooms, explore the area a little bit. During the summer months this park is popular with families, and you can see kids playing around, family BBQs, celebrations, etc. After this 15 minute pause I proceed until I get to Ojai, where I am in the habit of stopping for lunch at the rather average Mexican restaurant Los Caporales, nothing exciting there but their beers are cold, and the Mexican fare is acceptable. And one can park the bikes right in front of the terrace so that you can keep an eye on it, something quite important in the whole area because bikes are often stolen.
