

## Milestones for Casa Conejo Municipal Advisory Council

- Greater Casa Conejo communication with Supervisor, County and City staff, Sheriffs' Department and California Highway Patrol
- Provided input that resulted in better design of the Wendy Drive 101 interchange
- California Highway Patrol speed trailer locations and patrols based on MAC and community input
- New crosswalk at Rudman Drive and Lesser Drive installed, along with painted curbs for loading and no parking, for enhanced safety at Walnut Elementary School
- MAC-recommended new traffic signal at Wendy Drive and Gerald Drive received funding
- Motivated construction improvements on Old Conejo Road to correct long-standing drainage problems on Frankie Drive
- Initiated erosion control behind backyard of resident after presenting the problem at the MAC
- Moved up the timing of repaving Henry Drive based on resident input at MAC
- Street sweeping began in front of a residence near City and County border which had previously not been swept, based on input by resident at MAC
- Landscape Architects presented on appropriate street trees for neighborhood
- Organized volunteers to remove bulky items and debris from homes of residents who needed assistance, in coordination with Community Beautification Event
- Casa Conejo Graffiti Removal Intervention Team formed and reduced incidents of graffiti
- Casa Conejo Certified Emergency Response Team (CERT) formed
- Neighborhood Watch information seminar
- Created "Welcome Home" signs that were installed for community identification and to slow traffic
- Surveyed residents to gauge concerns and needs to better assist community
- Successful award of grant funds to study pedestrian/bicycle/ADA path along Arroyo Conejo
- Initiated volunteer tree planting program
