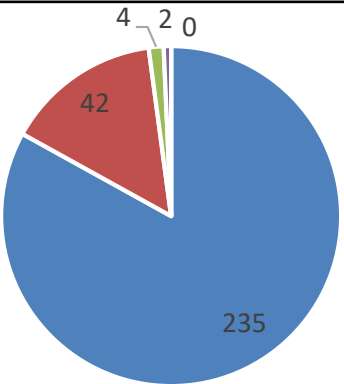
Community Satisfaction

Average: 18 years, 6 months

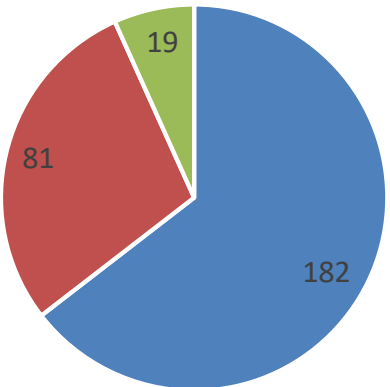
Median: 18 years

How quiet is your neighborhood?



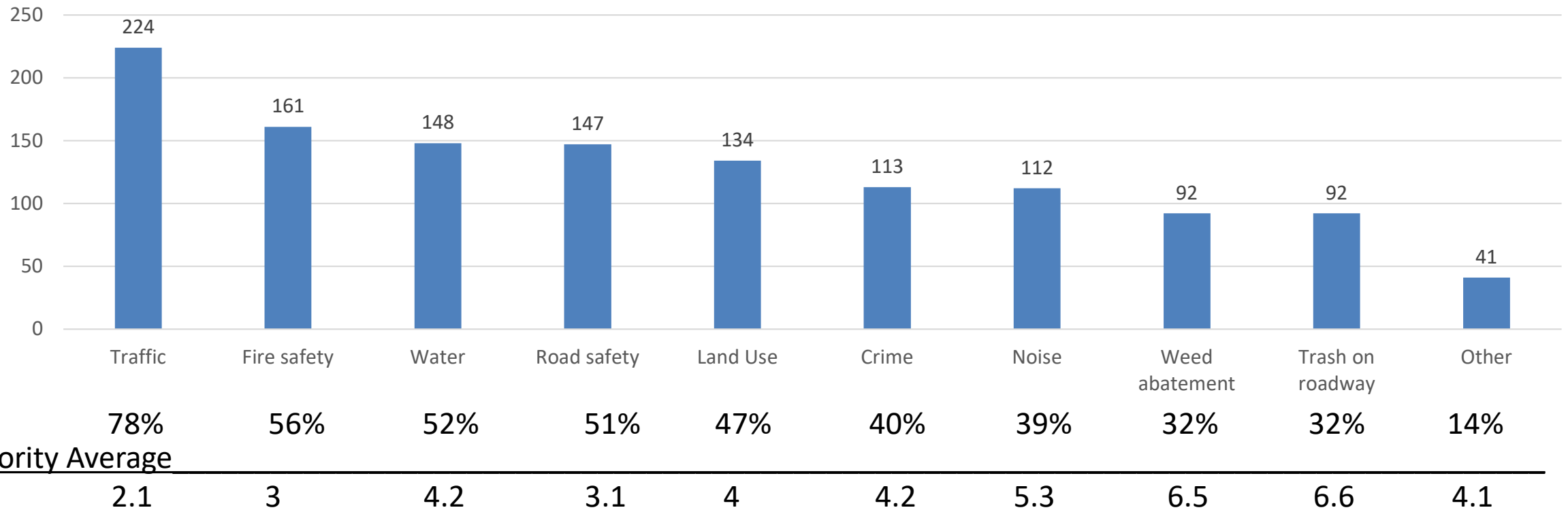
■ Very Quiet 65%

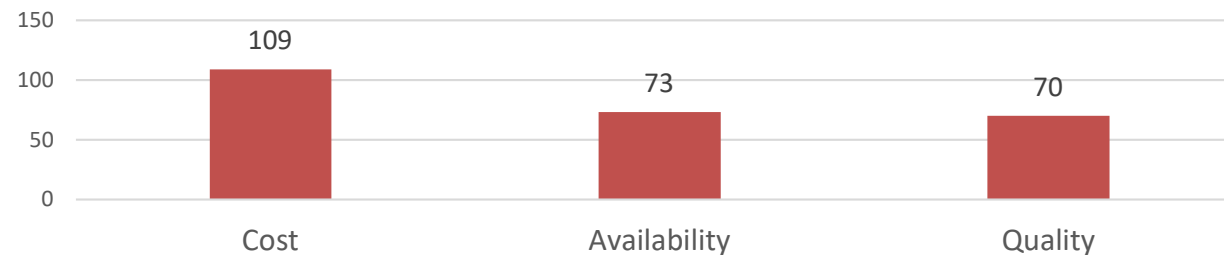
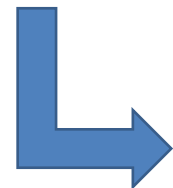

- **Southern California Edison**

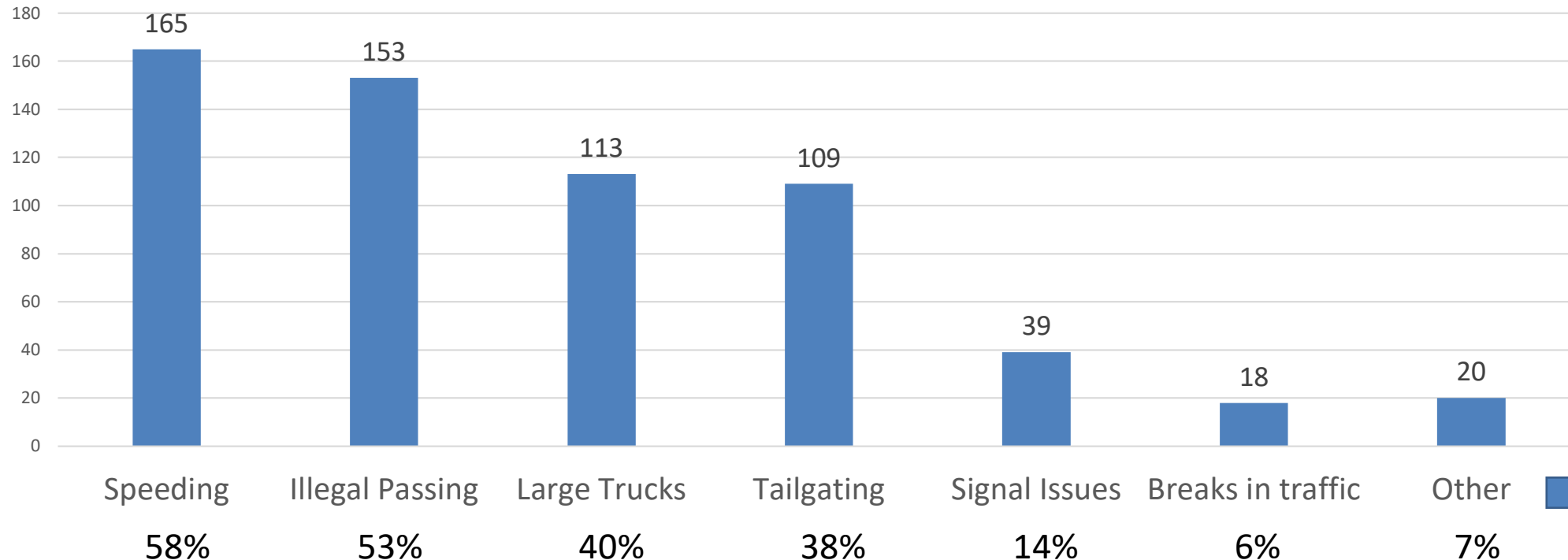
- Power shut offs, outages

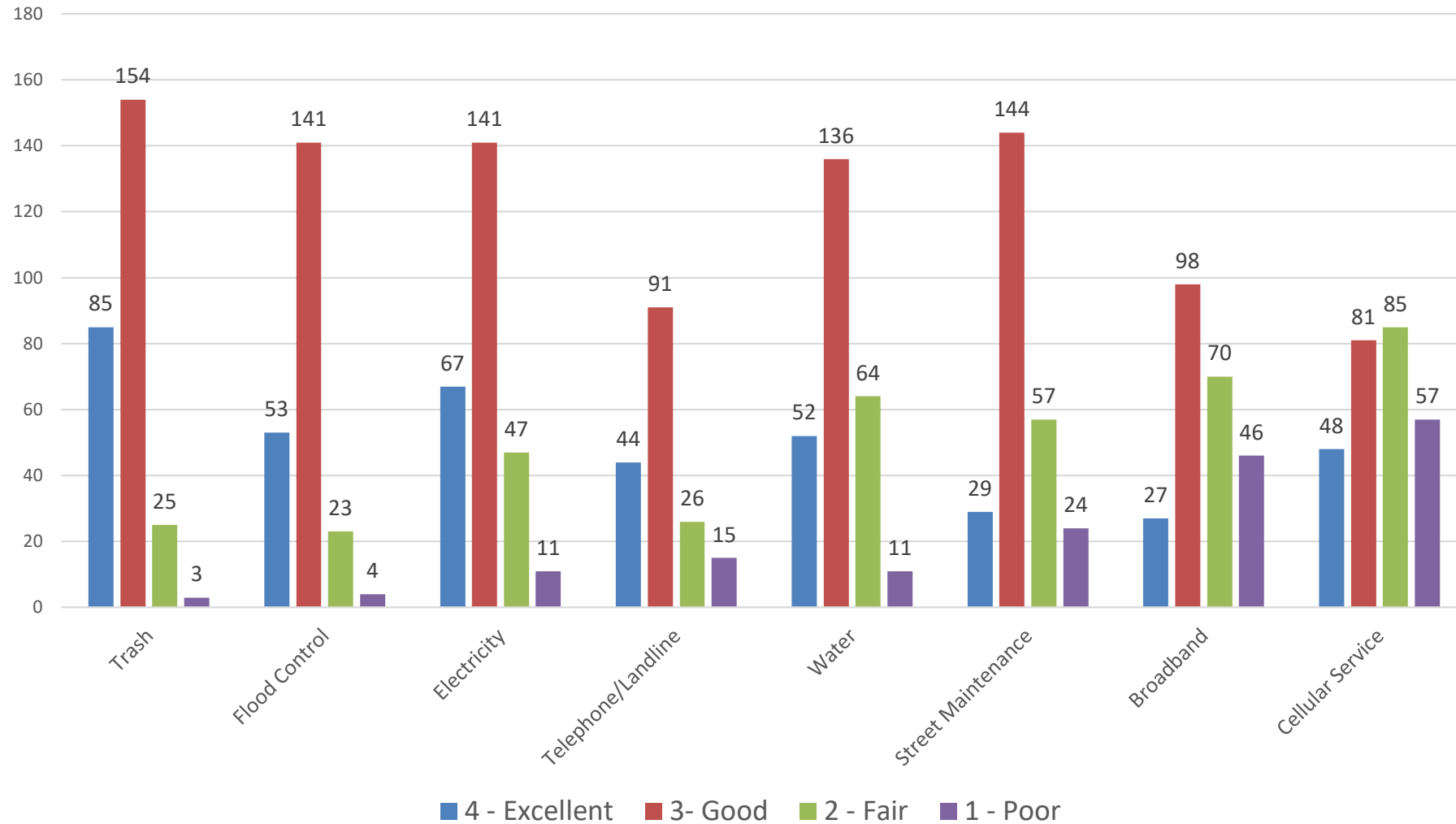
- Peak rush hours, 7-9am, 4-6pm

- Trash on Santa Rosa Road

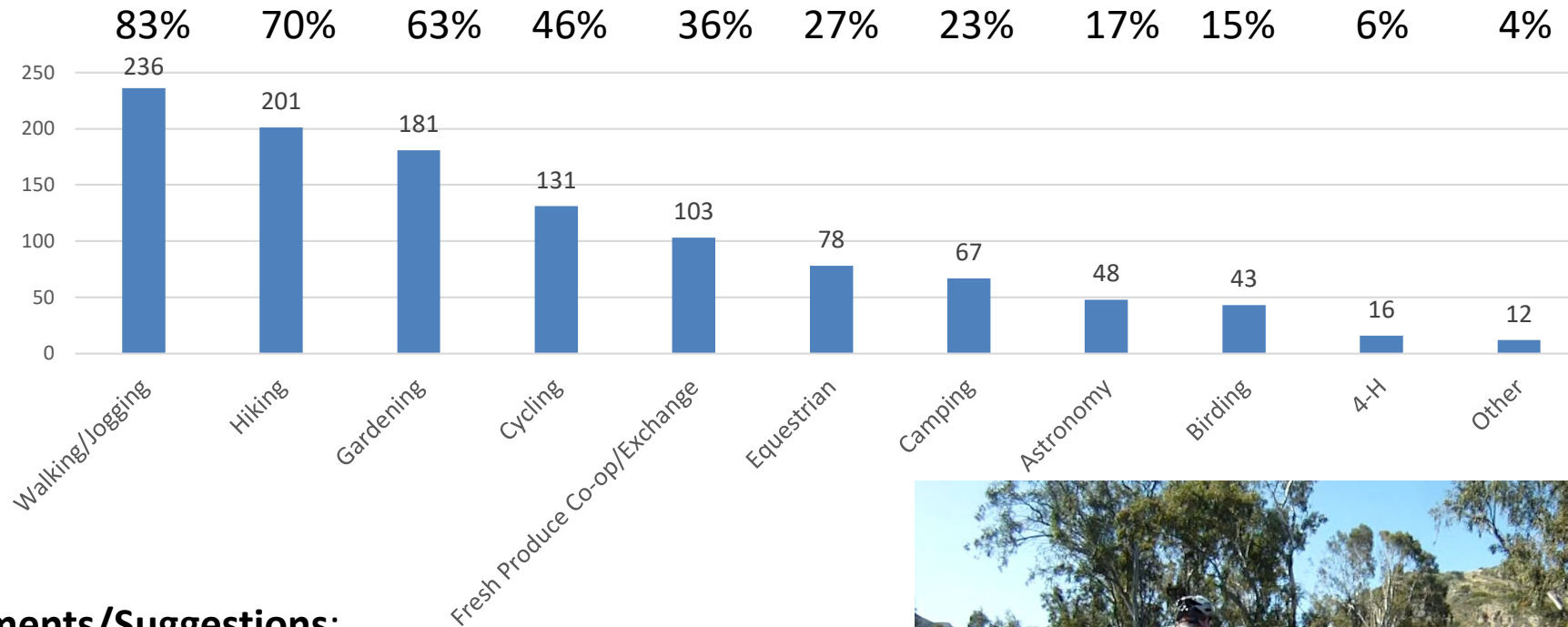
Communication Services

What type of outdoor activities are you interested in?



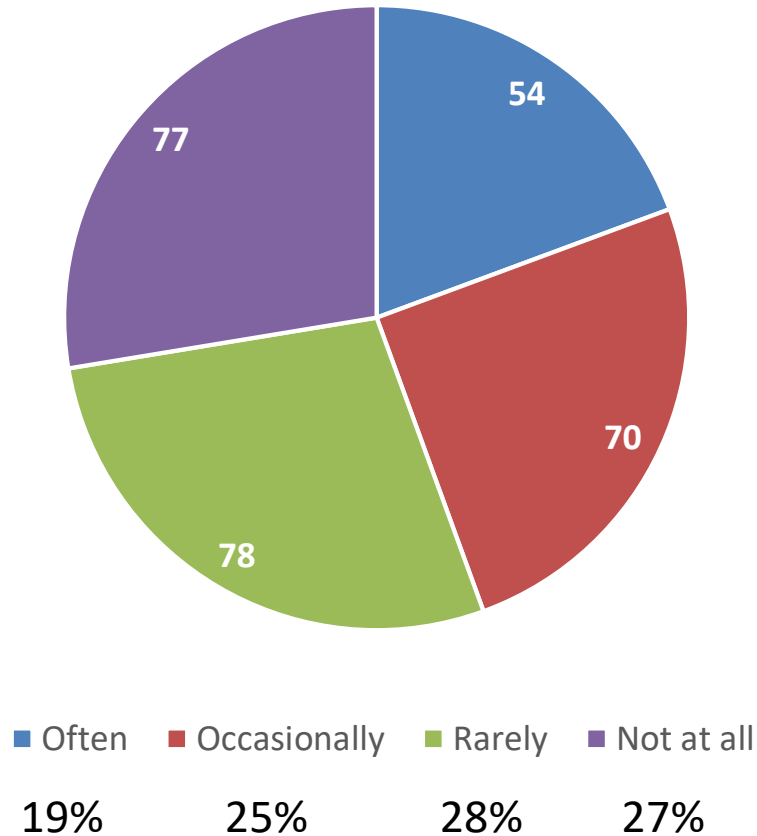

- Exercise activities – Yoga, Bootcamp, Basketball, Tennis, Golfing, Swimming

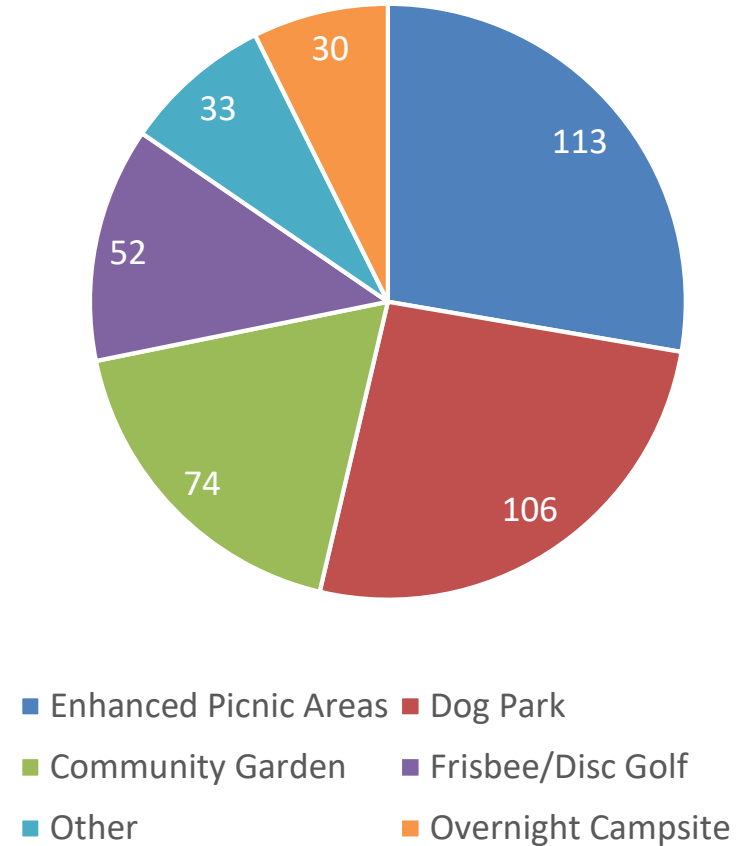


SANTA ROSA REGIONAL PARK

- Bike park, bike repair stand

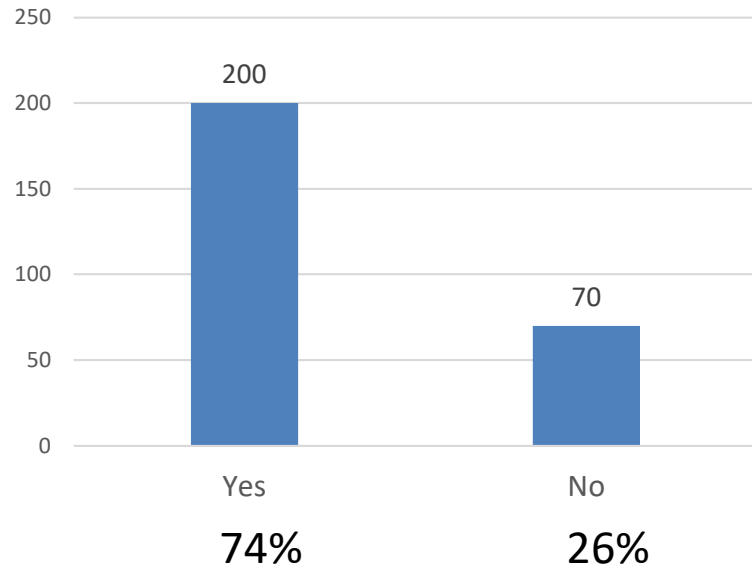
Comments of note:

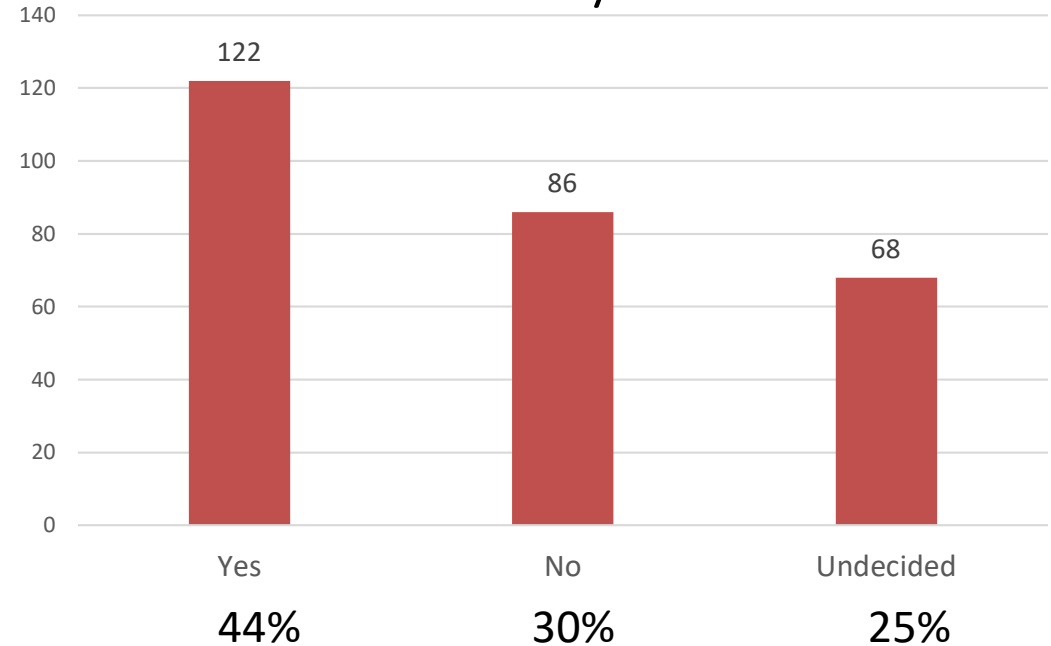
Would you like to see the County consider other options for weed control?

Would you be interested in having the MAC investigate a Dark Sky Ordinance in Santa Rosa Valley?

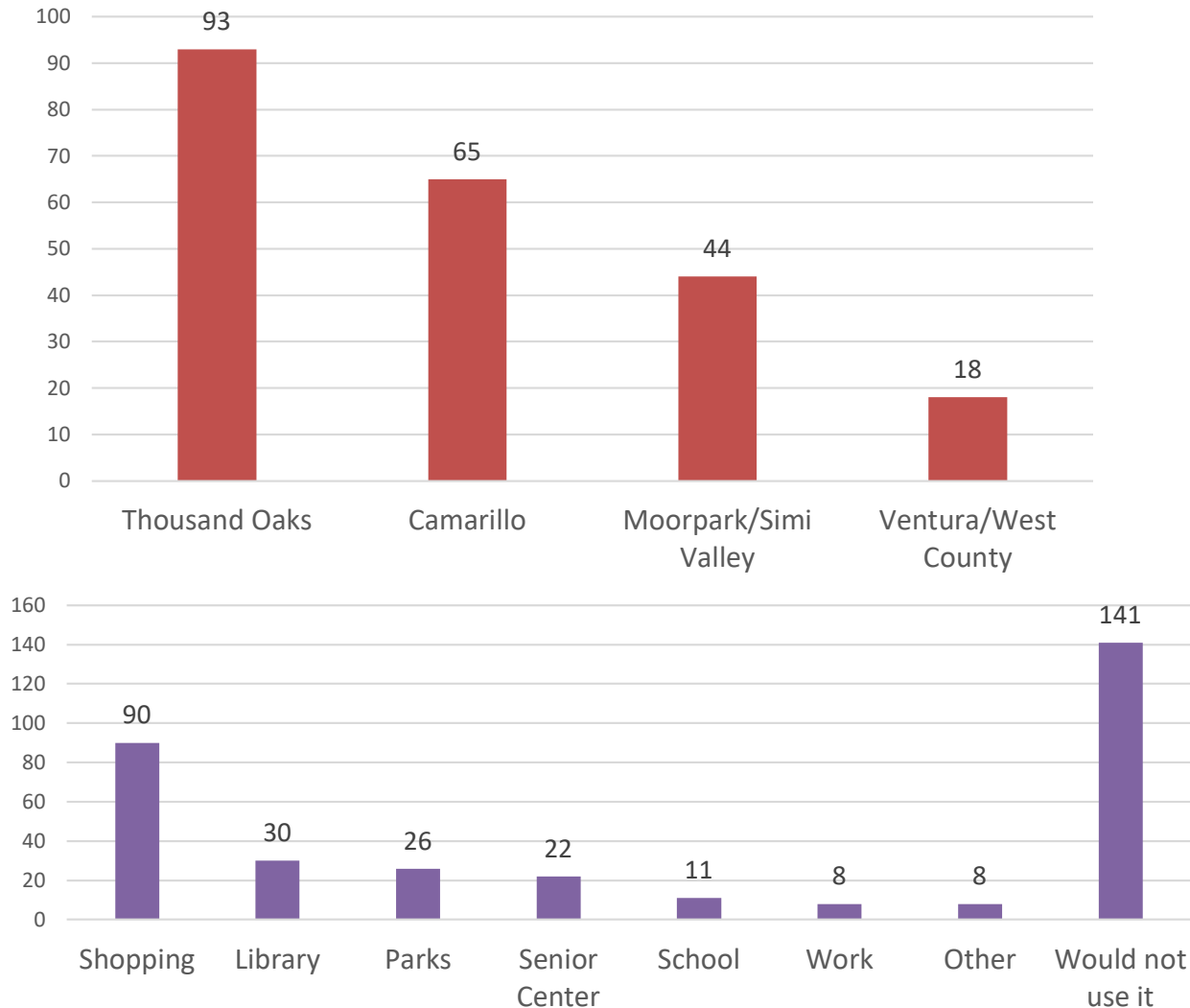

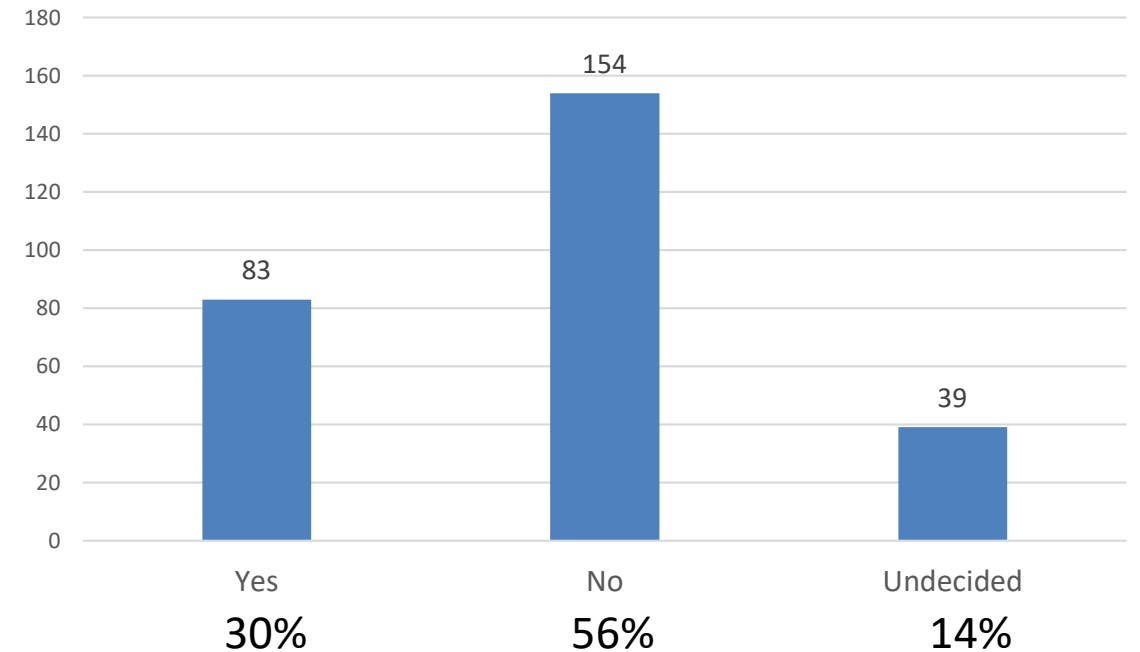
