III. Approval of Meeting Summary for May 19, 2022

IV. Public Safety Updates

Deputy Calderon introduced himself to attendees as the V.C. Sheriff's Office beat coordinator of the El Rio/Nyeland Acres community. His safety updates consisted of a drug overdose, a shooting on the 31st block (Cortez St) with no injury, and traffic violations. He is also working with the Homeless Liaison Officer, Public Works, and Fire to clean up the homeless encampments in the area.

Lt. Perez with CHP gave an updated on the moving violations resulting in citations, three parking complaints with two towed vehicles because of expired registration and parking citations. He indicated there is a full-time outreach officer (Officer Byrd) for the El Rio/Nyeland Acers community.
