VIII. Promotoras Presentation – Esperanza Agraz and Gloria Magana

Gloria Magana presented "Creando Comunida" (Creating Community). She spoke about speed concerns on Santa Clara Avenue. Homeowners who live on Santa Clara Ave struggle with parking and not being able to exit their homes safely because of the obstruction of view from cars. Farmworkers who work in the fields tend to park on the residential side due to lack of parking, which makes it a problem for residents. On trash days, residents have to line up their trash cans vertically and mail often doesn't get delivered because there is nowhere to stop/park. Explained how unsafe this is for residents especially as young drivers start learning how to drive.
