DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

Interests in real property located within the jurisdiction, within two miles of the boundaries of the jurisdiction, or within two miles of any land owned or used by Vista Real Public Charter, Inc. Persons are not required to disclose property such as a home or vacation cabin used exclusively as a personal residence; however, a residence in which a person rents out a room, or for which a person claims a business deduction, may be reportable.

Category 2:

Designated positions assigned to this category must report:

Investments and business positions in business entities, and income (including loans, gifts and travel payments) received from sources, that manufacture, provide or sell services and/or supplies of a type utilized by Vista Real Public Charter, Inc.

Category 3:

Designated positions assigned to this category must report:

Investments and business positions in business entities, and income (including loans, gifts and travel payments) received from sources, that manufacture, provide or sell services and/or supplies of a type utilized by the Vista Real Public Charter, Inc. location(s) overseen by the designated position.

Category 4:

Designated positions assigned to this category must report:

Investments and business positions in business entities, and income (including loans, gifts and travel payments) received from sources, that manufacture, provide or sell services and/or supplies of a type utilized by Vista Real Public Charter, Inc. and are associated with the job assignment of the designated position.
