



Diversity & Inclusion Task Force Term Limits and Attendance Requirements



TERM LIMITS

The term of membership for individuals on the Diversity and Inclusion Task Force shall be three (3) years. At the conclusion of a three-year term, a Diversity and Inclusion Task Force member may be reappointed for a second or third three-year term by consensus of the Task Force. No individual may serve more than nine (9) consecutive years on the Task Force. An individual may serve again after at least a one (1) year absence. Exceptions may be made at the discretion of the Diversity and Inclusion Task Force.

ABSENCES

Diversity and Inclusion Task Force members who have either been absent from three (3) consecutive Task Force meetings (excused or unexcused) or who are absent for more than 50 percent of meetings within the past 12 months may be automatically removed from the Task Force. Task Force members shall apprise staff assigned to the Diversity and Inclusion Task Force of anticipated absences. Please note the use of the word MAY, which affords the D&I Task Force the latitude to enforce this or not...depending on the circumstances of the absence.

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
