County to provide recovery information at community meeting for Bell Canyon residents affected by the Woolsey fire

VENTURA, Calif - The County of Ventura will provide fire recovery information at a community meeting for Bell Canyon residents who have been affected by the recent fires. The meeting will take place:

Subject matter experts will provide important information on watershed and debris flow assessments, public health concerns, debris removal, and rental assistance and local resources. Staff representing these areas will be available to answer questions following the presentation.

Please be aware that everyday household toxins are present in ash and debris and can present significant health hazards. While we understand that residents are eager to begin clean-up, we ask that you wait until professional hazardous material removal services are secured. More information will be available on such services at the Town Hall meetings.
