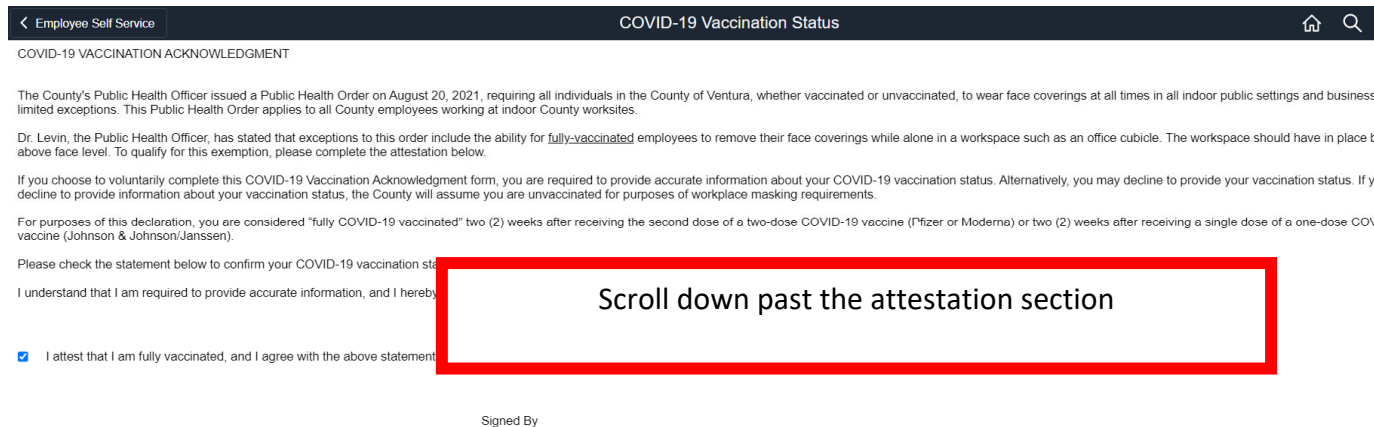
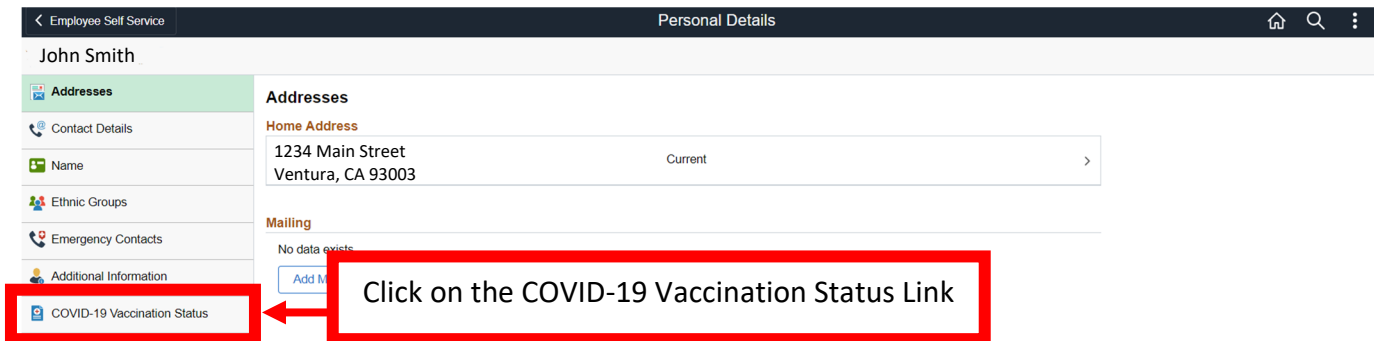
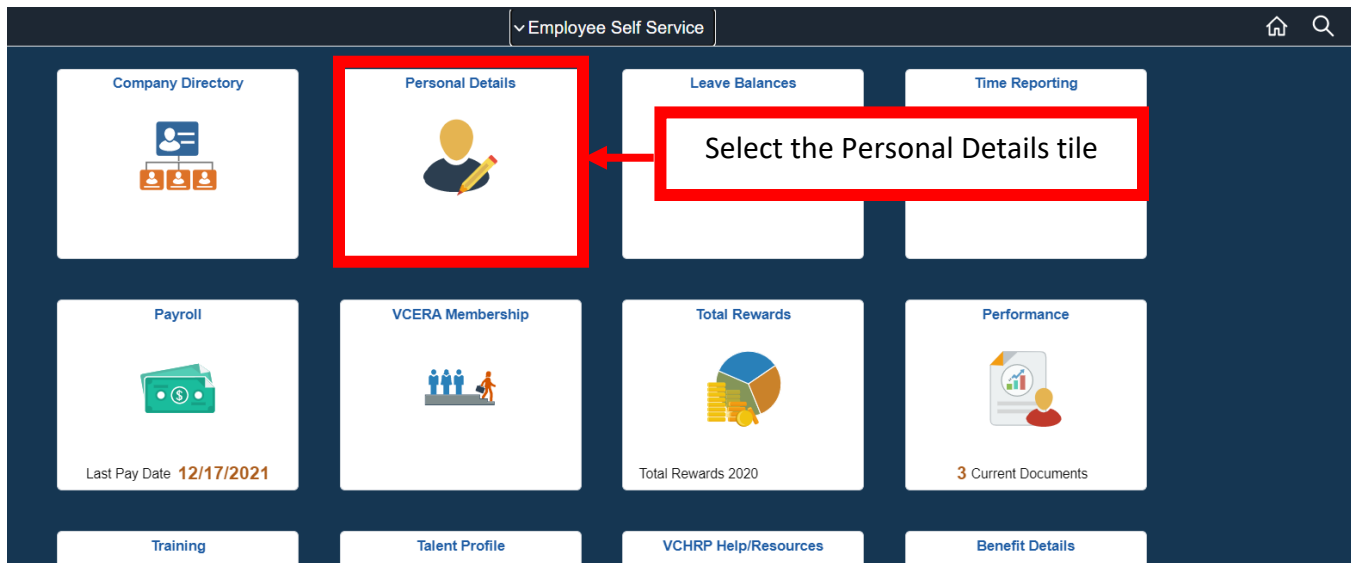


Accessing the online COVID-19 Booster Verification

For those employees who are required to submit proof of vaccination status (as defined in the "State Public Health Officer Order of July 26, 2021"), you may do so by clicking the button below and uploading a copy of vaccination proof. Definitions of who this order applies to and what documentation is acceptable are listed below.

For those employees who are required to submit proof of vaccination but are instead requesting an exemption (per "State Public Health Officer Order of August 5, 2021"), you may do so by clicking the button below and uploading a copy of the signed declination form and supporting documentation, if required. Definitions of what documentation is required to request an exemption are listed below.

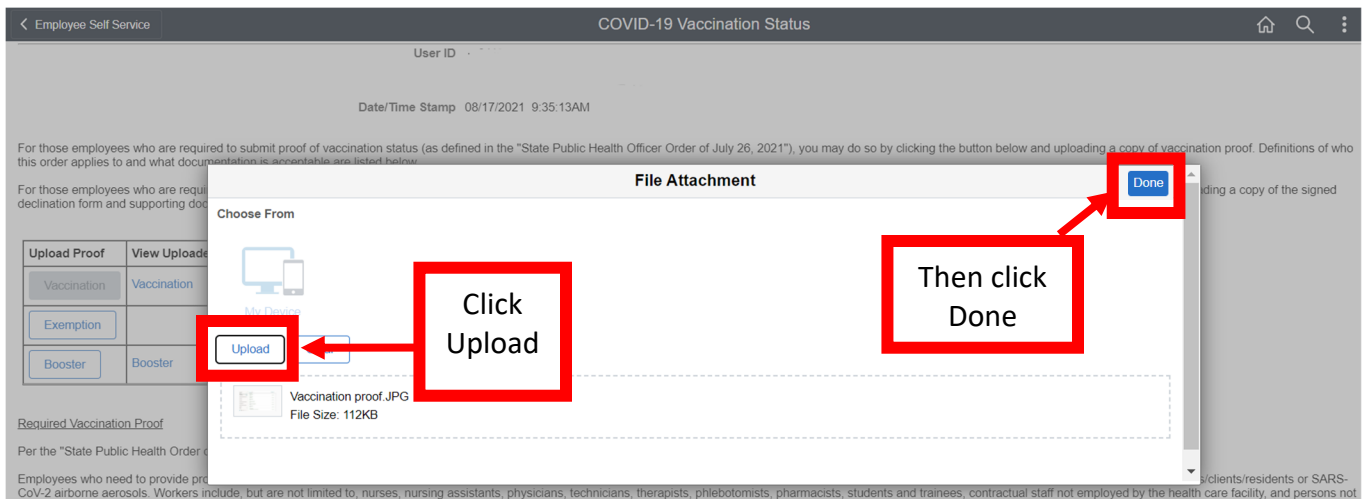
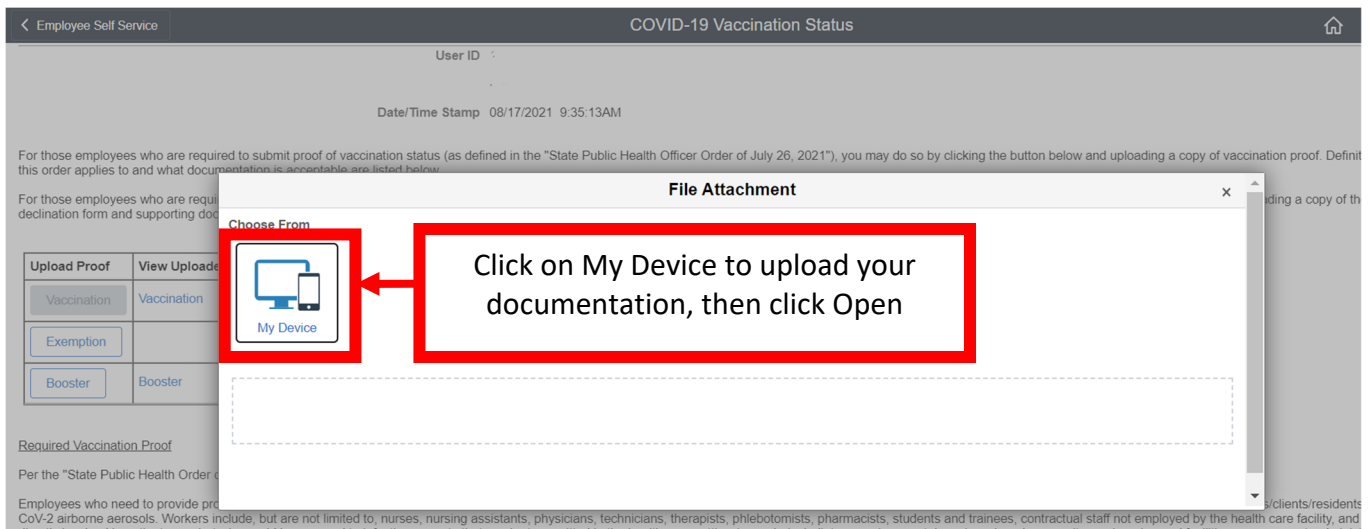
Required Vaccination Proof

Per the "State Public Health Order of July 26, 2021":

Employees who need to provide proof of vaccination status include "all paid and unpaid persons serving in health care, other health care or congregate settings who have the potential for direct or indirect exposure to patients/clients/residents or SARS-CoV-2 airborne aerosols. Workers include, but are not limited to, nurses, nursing assistants, physicians, technicians, therapists, phlebotomists, pharmacists, students and trainees, contractual staff not employed by the health care facility, and persons not directly involved in patient care, but who could be exposed to infectious agents that can be transmitted in the health care setting (e.g., clerical, dietary, environmental services, laundry, security, engineering and facilities management, administrative, billing, and volunteer personnel)."

Per the "State Public Health Order of December 22, 2021":

All workers currently eligible for boosters who provide services or work in facilities requiring employees be fully vaccinated (as previously defined in the "State Public Health Order of July 26, 2021") must be "fully vaccinated and boosted" for COVID-19 receiving all recommend doses of the primary series of vaccines and a vaccine booster dose no later than February 1, 2022.
