

TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM

The Transportation Benefit Reimbursement Program is a voluntary benefit option available to all regular full-time and part-time employees of the County of Ventura who perform services and receive wages. The account allows eligible employees to set aside money in a special nontaxable account from which your funds are released for eligible “mass transit” expenses to and from work. Employees can contribute up to the monthly maximum amount set by the IRS. - 1** Covers Employees Only. Covers all public transit (i.e. train, bus).
