The County of Ventura plans to conduct a public hearing on a proposed amendment to its Permanent Local Housing Allocation Plan (PLHA Plan). The purpose of this hearing is to receive comments and seek Board of Supervisor's approval before transmitting the amended PLHA Plan to the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD).

The County of Ventura is the lead agency in the development of the PLHA Plan, which includes the Ventura Urban County Entitlement Area (comprised of the unincorporated areas and the cities of Fillmore, Moorpark, Ojai, Port Hueneme, and Santa Paula), and the City of Thousand Oaks.

The primary goal of the PLHA program is to create a permanent source of funding available to eligible local governments in California for housing-related projects and programs that address the unmet housing needs of local communities. As required by HCD, the PLHA Plan sets forth the types of activities to be funded with the County's allocation of PLHA during the first five years of implementation and the percentage of funds dedicated to each activity.
