Highlights

4/12/2011 12th Annual Housing Rights Summit

The Housing Rights Center presented the 12th Annual Housing Rights Summit. The Summit commemorated National Fair Housing Month and the 43rd Anniversary of the Fair Housing Act. The Summit theme: "Fair Housing Is At Your Door" featured keynote speaker André Birotte Jr., United States Attorney for the Central District of California. Topic presentations and discussions throughout the day included: fair lending and foreclosure and the impact of the foreclosure crisis on low-income families, seniors, and communities of color; housing as a human right with special emphasis on housing rights for undocumented individuals, ex-offenders, and homeless populations; sexual orientation discrimination; and disability discrimination with special emphasis on stigma reduction for mental health disabilities, hoarding and disability discrimination within the public service and housing sector. Over 195 community representatives, government staff, legal aid professionals, and students attended the event. Each participant received an event packet and bag that included the agenda, speaker information, a CD with materials and handouts, and a community directory guide. The 12th Annual Summit also featured a Health and Resource Fair which brought together over 25 nonprofit organizations, government agencies, and legal aid agencies for the purpose of sharing information about their services and programs to Summit attendees.

The year long project, entitled the Fair Housing Initiatives Program (FHIP), allows fair housing organizations to proactively investigate and address housing discrimination, raise public awareness of the Fair Housing Act, and work to promote and support equal housing opportunities. The program will consist of systemic fair housing testing investigations in areas within Los Angeles County which HRC complaint statistics show to be experiencing all forms of discrimination covered by fair housing laws, including persistent housing discrimination based on race, familial status and disability. Under the FHIP Project, HRC will also provide public workshops and trainings on fair housing issues to a variety of different audiences such as property owners, managers, and tenants throughout Los Angeles County. Another project component consists of distributing fair housing information written in languages other than English, such as, Spanish, Chinese, Korean, and Russian.
