Free Seminar March 4: “Meet Your Civil Grand Jury”

The Ventura County Grand Jury will hold a free seminar on Wednesday, March 4, from 10 to 11 a.m. in the Board Room of the Ventura County Community Foundation, 4001 Mission Oaks Blvd., Camarillo.

The program is open to all Ventura County residents. The civil grand jury is an all-volunteer “watchdog” group that investigates complaints from the public, researches and writes reports, and makes recommendations about all aspects of local and county government—for example, city councils, school districts, libraries, jails, hospitals, harbors and water districts. You’ll learn the difference between the civil and criminal grand juries; how the civil grand jury functions; how to make a complaint about something you feel needs investigating; and how to apply to serve as a grand juror.
