We have reviewed the Grand Jury's Report and note that they made no recommendations requiring a response by the Sheriff's Department.

The Grand Jury conducted an audit of the Todd Road Jail Facility. Additionally, the Grand Jury pursued an inquiry into the deployment and training of K-9 units by the county's public safety agencies.

The Todd Road Jail audit focused on: Personnel and Management Training; Records and Public Information; Inmate Programs and Activities; Discipline; Medical/Mental Health Services; Food; Inmate Clothing and Personal Hygiene; Bedding and Linens; and Facilities Sanitation and Safety. Four minor text edits recommended to the facility's Policies and Procedures Manual have been made that will provide more clarity of the facilities procedures.

The recommendations made relating to funding sources and public awareness programs are already in place within the Sheriff's K-9 Program.

The employees of the Sheriff's Department and I appreciate the Grand Jury's commendation of our efforts in the operation of the Todd Road Jail Facility,
