Appendix I: Legal requirements for responses

Section 933.05 - Response to Finding

(a) For purposes of subdivision (b) of Section 933, as to each grand jury finding, the responding person or entity shall indicate one of the following:

- (1) The respondent agrees with the finding.
- (2) The respondent disagrees wholly or partially with the finding, in which case the response shall specify the portion of the finding that is disputed and shall include an explanation of the reasons therefor.

(b) For purposes of subdivision (b) of Section 933, as to each grand jury recommendation, the responding person or entity shall report one of the following actions:

- (1) The recommendation has been implemented, with a summary regarding the implemented action.
- (2) The recommendation has not yet been implemented, but will be implemented in the future, with a timeframe for implementation.
- (3) The recommendation requires further analysis, with an explanation and the scope and parameters of an analysis or study, and a timeframe for the matter to be prepared for discussion by the officer or head of the agency or department being investigated or reviewed, including the governing body of the public agency when applicable. This timeframe shall not exceed six months from the date of publication of the grand jury report.
- (4) The recommendation will not be implemented because it is not warranted or is not reasonable, with an explanation therefor.

(c) However, if a finding or recommendation of the grand jury addresses budgetary or personnel matters of a county agency or department headed by an elected officer, both the agency or department head and the board of supervisors shall respond if requested by the grand jury, but the response of the board of supervisors shall address only those budgetary or personnel matters over which it has some decisionmaking authority. The response of the elected agency or department head shall address all aspects of the findings or recommendations affecting his or her agency or department.

(d) A grand jury may request a subject person or entity to come before the grand jury for the purpose of reading and discussing the findings of the grand jury report that relates to that person or entity in order to verify the accuracy of the findings prior to their release.

(e) During an investigation, the grand jury shall meet with the subject of that investigation regarding the investigation, unless the court, either on its own determination or upon request of the foreperson of the grand jury, determines that such a meeting would be detrimental.

(f) A grand jury shall provide to the affected agency a copy of the portion of the grand jury report relating to that person or entity two working days prior to its public release and after the approval of the presiding judge. No officer, agency, department, or governing body of a public agency shall disclose any contents of the report prior to the public release of the final report.

Appendix II: Responses to 1997-1998 Grand Jury Report

This report is being issued to provide an analysis of the responses to last year's Grand Jury report. It is the first such report to be issued by any Ventura County Grand Jury.

Background

Recent changes in state law (AB 829 and AB 1907) regarding responses to Grand Jury reports were made to provide greater continuity in Grand Jury activities from year to year. The 1998-1999 Grand Jury encourages the facilitation of this. Accordingly, this report will provide the following information:

Statistical analysis of responses to last year's report with regard to timeliness, compliance with legal requirements (see below), and degree of concurrence with Grand Jury recommendations. The report will also comment on those recommendations that were not agreed to with suggestions for future action.

Penal Code 933.05 requires that the responses meet one of the four following criteria:

1. Recommendation has been implemented.
2. Recommendation will be implemented, with a timetable for implementation.
3. More time is required for analysis, up to six months being allowed.
4. Recommendation will not be implemented, with an explanation.

Findings

Figure 1 shows the late responses. Twenty of 53 required responses were late from a few days to 4½ months. This Grand Jury found it necessary to make verbal and written reminders.

Figure 2 shows the number of recommendations accepted or not accepted. Agencies agreed to 95% of the recommendations. Of the eight that were not agreed to, seven provided a satisfactory explanation and therefore are in compliance with the penal code requirement for responses. No comment was made on recommendations regarding adoption in the report on Foster Care. The overall record is therefore fairly good.

The County Clerk maintains a complete file of all Grand Jury reports and responses. On the basis of recent change in the law, the County Clerk issues instructions to all agencies in the county (including cities) on how to respond.

Conclusions

Two-thirds of agencies responded in a timely fashion and with intent to comply. Although most recommendations are agreed to, the almost universal problem with responses is that there is no timetable for implementation.

Recommendations

All agencies (city, county, and special districts) should review the requirements of the penal code and provide timely and responsive answers to the Grand Jury, and make distribution as instructed. For reference purposes, governing bodies (i.e. County Board of Supervisors and City Councils) must respond within 90 days and other elected officials (e.g. District Attorney or an elected City Clerk) and other agencies must respond within 60 days.

All responses that concur with the Grand Jury's recommendations must include a timetable for action to be responsive to the requirements of the penal code.

Future Grand Juries should issue interim final reports throughout their term for the following reasons:

1. Reports are issued while the investigations are fresher in the minds of the jury and the agencies involved.
2. Responses will be available for the sitting and issuing jury to receive and review.

When interim final reports are duplicated in the final report, the date of the interim report should be included in the final report.

Acknowledgment

We are grateful to the 1997-1998 Santa Barbara Grand Jury which was one of the first to issue a report of this type.
