Recommendation R-1: A long-term, comprehensive funding strategy should

be drafted to ensure the continuation of the program,

including its capital and operational needs.

Response The Chief Executive Office concurs with staff

response and further recognizes and supports that staff is working with dedicated volunteers in on-going

fund raising efforts

Recommendation R-2: The County Board of Supervisors should continue its

support of the program and not initiate any change in oversight responsibilities until after the move to new

quarters in 2002.

Response The Chief Executive Office concurs with staff and

supports the notion that no significant change in management should occur until renovation of the transition living center is completed and occupancy

occurs

Recommendation R-3: The current management team should recruit a strong

and capable Board of Directors that will enable the program to grow within a stable financial environment.

Response The County Executive Office agrees with staff

recommendation that an independent Board of Directors will be created to guide RAIN and create an

increasingly stable financial environment.

Recommendation R-4: The current management team should investigate use

of low-income housing offset funds (those funds builders pay to compensate for lack of low-income units under development) to expand services to this

population.

participation on the Organization of Governments is

the best approach to investigate this potential.
