The Department is unable to comment on these findings not because they are not accurate or because the Department does not agree, but rather because they cover areas of fact finding unrelated to the Behavioral Health Department's own scope of fact verification.

Recommendations:

R12: The Public Guardian should prepare and implement a monthly schedule of visits to all facilities for face-to-face meetings with conservate patients to ensure that the patients are being treated appropriately and are in a healthy environment.
