SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES FOR CITY SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Fillmore has conducted an analysis of its services, the costs reasonably borne of providing those services, the beneficiaries of those services, and the revenue produced by those paying fees and charges for special services; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to establish a policy of recovering the full costs reasonably borne of providing city services; and

WHEREAS, on the basis of evidence listed below, all public notice and hearing requirements prescribed in Government Code Section 66018(a) and 6062(a) have been satisfied

- a. Prior to adoption of this Resolution, a public hearing was conducted by the City Council on June 21, 2011.
- b. Written notice of the public hearing conducted by the City Council on June 21, 2011, was published in the legal section of the newspaper of general circulation on June 2, 2011 and June 9, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Fillmore, determine and order as follows:

The following schedule of fees and charges are hereby directed to be computed by and applied by the various City departments, and are to be collected by the City Finance Department for the herein listed special services when provided by the City or its designated contractors.

All fees set forth by this resolution are for each identified process; additional fees shall be required for each additional process or service that is requested or required. Where fees are indicated on a per unit of measurement basis the fee is for each identified unit or portion thereof within the indicated ranges of such units.
