## SUBSTANTIATED ISSUES

1. Issue 22-0035, Lack of Notice of Potential Exposure to COVID-19: A County department did not notify employees of a potential exposure to COVID-19 in the workplace, in noncompliance with California Labor Code Section 6409.6. Going forward, all personnel responsible for monitoring reports of potential COVID-19 exposure are to be advised as to California Assembly Bill 685 requirements regarding record keeping, identification of potential exposure, and mandated notification procedures.
