# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS REGARDING POOL CLOSURES DUE TO THE COVID-19 LOCAL HEALTH EMERGENCY – Updated 7/30/2020

## ARE PUBLIC POOLS ALLOWED TO OPEN?

Effective 6/12/2020, all pools are allowed to open. Community pools must complete a social distancing plan, residential style pools (HOA's, apartments, hotels) do not require a plan but are recommended to do so. See the protocol guidelines <a href="here">here</a>. Indoor pools may open at 25% capacity.

# **CAN OUR MEDICAL THERAPY POOL REMAIN OPEN?**

Yes. It is recommended to only see one patient at a time to ensure proper social distancing.

## CAN WE CLOSE THE RESTROOM FACILITY AT OUR SWIMMING POOL?

No. The provided restroom and shower facilities are required per Title 24 and are necessary for proper bather sanitation.

#### DO POOL PATRONS NEED TO WEAR MASKS?

Maybe. The state mandate to wear masks does not apply when individuals are outdoors and can maintain social distancing. Masks are required when 6-foot social distancing cannot be maintained. Pool users should not wear a face covering while in the water. It may be necessary to require face coverings for indoor facilities – please review the <a href="state">state</a> guidance to ensure compliance.

## **HOW OFTEN DO WE NEED TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT?**

The frequency of cleaning will depend on the frequency of pool usage. It is up to the community association/pool facility to determine an adequate cleaning schedule and to assure that the cleaning is done.

## ARE ONE-ON-ONE SWIM LESSONS ALLOWED?

All-age one-on-one drowning prevention classes are allowed with Certified Infant Swim instructors only.

# WILL YOU BE CONDUCTING ROUTINE INSPECTIONS?

Yes. Routine inspections of pools that have re-opened will commence.

# WHAT IS THE FREQUENCY OF INSPECTION, AND WHAT ARE YOU LOOKING FOR?

Upon notification of the pool facility's re-opening, an inspector will contact the listed contact person to schedule an inspection. The inspection will consist of the usual routine inspection, as well as a "consultation"-style inspection that will cover the COVID protocols implemented by the facility. A follow-up inspection may be scheduled if corrections are needed. Additional inspections may be performed if complaints about the facility are received by this Division.
