

• The CARES Act Payroll Protection Program kicked off on April 3 for small businesses, and will be available for self-employed and independent contractors on April 10. Businesses are encouraged to apply for these PPP SBA loans through their local banks. If businesses meet the criteria (including retaining or hiring back staff), these loans can be forgiven. Here is a Protection Program Guide and Checklist created by the U.S. Chamber of Commerce.

Business Service Provider Sector (EDC, WEV, Chambers)

- Both the Economic Development Collaborative <u>EDC</u> and Women's Economic Ventures <u>WEV</u> offer Spanish business consulting services.
- Since March 1, EDC has engaged 1,530 clients.
