



COVID-19 VACCINE FREEZER LOAN PROGRAM

The County of Ventura is looking to partner with local clinics and physicians to provide no-cost, refrigerators and freezers, for storing and administering the COVID-19 vaccine. There is no cost to participate in the program and vaccine and ancillary supplies are provided to your practice, free of charge by the California Department of Public Health. You may not charge an office visit or other fee if COVID-19 vaccination is the sole medical service provided. However, you may seek appropriate reimbursement from a program or plan that covers COVID-19 Vaccine administration fees for the vaccine recipient, such as private insurance companies, Medicare or Medicaid reimbursement, or HRSA COVID-19 Uninsured program for non-insured vaccine recipients.

How to Join the Program

1. Enroll in the [California COVID-19 Vaccination Program](#). to be an approved COVID-19 vaccine administrator. Before you apply, visit the [COVID-19 EZIZ](#) website for information about program updates, vaccine management, vaccine administration, etc.
2. Sign a [license agreement with the County of Ventura](#) promising to return the freezer/refrigerator you are loaned at the conclusion of the COVID-19 pandemic. To start this process please email Patrick.Maynard@ventura.org.
3. Upon completing your application with CDPH and completing the license agreement with the County of Ventura, the delivery of your refrigerator/freezer unit will be coordinated.
4. Once you are ready to administer vaccines, you must agree to participate in marketing efforts lead by the County of Ventura. This includes having your practice listed on the venturacountyrecovers.org website.
