



Student Health Decision Tree

Screen all students for potential COVID-19 symptoms or exposure

Symptoms commonly found with COVID-19 or other viral infections



Symptoms frequently associated with COVID-19



Exposure to COVID-19 positive person

CDPH recommendations for staying home when sick and getting tested:
NEW symptom/s **commonly** or **frequently** found with COVID-19 that is a change from the student's baseline



STAY HOME

To return to school, student will need to be fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication; and other symptoms have improved; and **ONE** of the following:

1. Confirm alternate diagnosis, with a doctor note **OR**
2. A negative COVID-19 test (Antigen or PCR) **OR**
3. A positive COVID-19 antigen or PCR test - **at least 5 days** have passed since symptom onset with a negative test on or after Day 5 (Antigen preferred) as long as symptoms are not present or are resolving **OR**
4. None of the above 3 options - at least 10 days from symptom.

Schools may use the Group-Tracing Approach to Students Exposed to COVID-19 in a K-12 setting.

Primary series* completed of COVID-19 vaccines OR previously infected with COVID-19 (laboratory confirmed) within the last 90 days

ATTEND SCHOOL

May remain in school and continue wearing a face mask.

Note: Testing is recommended 5-7 days after the close contact occurred. If they develop symptoms for COVID-19, they should be tested right away.

BOTH PERSONS HAD FACE MASKS ON



ATTEND SCHOOL

May continue attending in-person instruction if they meet **ALL** the following:

1. Are asymptomatic
2. Continue to wear face mask, as required
3. Test twice weekly during quarantine
4. Cannot attend any extracurricular school activities, including sports, conditioning, band practice, etc.

STAY HOME

To return to school, student will need to monitor their symptoms for 14 days from last exposure and **ONE** of the following:

1. *Quarantine can end after Day 5 if asymptomatic and a test collected on Day 5 or later is negative **OR***
2. *Quarantine can end after Day 10 if asymptomatic.*

*Note: Modified Quarantine can end after Day 5 if asymptomatic and a test collected on Day 5 or later is negative. Modified quarantine applies **only** to exposures that occur on the school campus.*
