## THE VACCINE IS ...

- ✓ SAFE
- ✓ FREE
- ✓ EASY

- ▶ The COVID-19 vaccine will not give you COVID-19.
- ▶ The vaccine protects you from getting COVID-19 or helps make the illness less severe.
- ▶ It is backed by medical experts.
- ▶ Any side effects are typically mild and disappear within a few days.
- ▶ Currently requires two doses (a few weeks apart).
- ▶ Getting vaccinated helps your community to stop the pandemic.

**How do I make an appointment for a vaccine?** You must be in Phase 1A health care sector or be 65 or older to receive a vaccine at this time. You can make an appointment by visiting [www.vcrecovers.org](http://www.vcrecovers.org) or by calling the registration hotline at 805-477-7161. Vaccines are provided to the County from the State every week. More appointments open every Monday. There are not enough vaccines provided to vaccinate all community members at one time. Vaccinations for all phases will last into the Fall.
