WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD

Role

Public board of local leaders from business, labor, education, economic development, government, and community organizations, appointed by the Ventura County Board of Supervisors to...

Administer Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title 1 funds.

Provide <u>oversight</u> for WIOA Title I workforce development programs and services to benefit job seekers, workers, youth and employers.

<u>Facilitate</u> regional collaboration, alignment, and leveraging of private/public resources to support business workforce needs.



SUCCESS STORY Pathpoint



Ricardo

Dropped out of High School in the 11th grade, discouraged because he was behind in credits and did not think he would graduate with his class. He was referred to PathPoint's Youth Networked Services, funded by WIOA where he found all the support he needed for enrolling in adult school and completing credits to earn his HS diploma.

Support included clothing and shoes to interview and secure a job. Ricardo was able to secure a paid internship at the Dollar Tree and upon completing his internship he was offered a job. He is now on the path to become an EMT and is very grateful for WIOA support.

SUCCESS STORY Pathpoint



Elena was raised by a single mother who worked in the fields. Elena had to start working at the age of 15 to help pay for food and rent. Her mother became disabled and she became the sole family provider. At some point she was unemployed and needed assistance, this is when she learned about the Youth Networked Services with PathPoint funded by WIOA. The WIOA-funded program allowed her to obtain a paid internship and at the same time start a Phlebotomy course. Elena now has a full time job in the related field.

SUCCESS STORY Boys & Girls Club of Greater Oxnard and Port Hueneme



Edith grew up in a large family and they struggled financially. She was diagnosed with cancer at a very young age. After remission, she was happy to put her illness behind and she started focusing on her educational and employment goals. Edith joined the Job Ready Program at the BGC, funded by WIOA. Through her participation in this program, she was able to obtain the training and financial assistance needed to pursue a CNA certificate. She is now employed at the Oxnard Manor Healthcare Center as a CNA.
