#### 4.0 Action Item: Programs Committee Appointments

The committee unanimously agreed to recommend to the WDB their consideration for appointment of Mr. Mantooth and the reappointment of Ms. Fisher-Helton to the Program Committee.

#### 5.0 Membership Status

- Reappointments: Committee members reviewed all WDB membership terms and discussed each member with no new reappointments required.
- Appointments: Committee members discussed board composition, WIOA categories of representation, required business member and workforce member ratios, and the engagement/recruitment process. Committee members discussed the recommendation from Naval Base Ventura County the potential appointment of Captain Kirk Lagerquist, as a non-voting member. WDB has enjoyed a long relationship with NBVC and respects the economic and workforce contributions to the Ventura region. WDB member recently from NBVC was Captain Douglas King who is retiring from the board effective July 3, 2019. Motion by Jesus Torres and second from Jeremy Goldberg to recommend WDB non-voting membership for Captain Lagerquist was unanimously accepted by the committee, and will be submitted to the county Board of Supervisors for their consideration.
- <u>Recruitments</u>: WDB membership has increased to 26 members, with the recent appointment of Laura. Martinez. The WDB will be required to maintain 20% of WDB membership in the Workforce category, and current need to add one Workforce Category member. Committee members discussed the addition of a Workforce category representative within the Labor/Apprenticeship subcategory category. Under the leadership of Jeremy Goldberg, the Tri Counties Labor Council will explore potential nominees with possible applications coming from the Operating Engineers local or Sheet Metal local. Applications will be submitted for consideration at the next Membership committee meeting.
- Attendance: Members discussed WDB member attendance at WDB and Committee meetings. Members agreed in the importance of WDB membership regularly attending the bi-monthly meetings is important to provide consistent and informed oversight of WIOA funds and programs.
